

Self Cleaner

Description:

Liquid and environment-friendly cleaner on the basis of enzymes which removes pollution and deposit of atmospheric origin on all outdoor surfaces.

The product works for you, no scrubbing required.

Use:

IKO pro Self Cleaner is used for: flat and pitched roofs (bitumen roof felt, slate-roofed, tiled, corrugated, ...); facades; terraces and garden furniture.

Caution is advised when the product is applied or splashed on certain types of powder coatings. First test the product on an invisible spot.

Packaging:

Jerrican of 5L (item number 05454140)

Storage:

3 years in the hermetically sealed packaging, when stored in a dry, cool and frostfree place.

Partly used containers may be resealed and used again after correct storage.

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure upright position.

Colour:

Transparent

Application:

Apply the liquid preferably to a dry or slightly damp surface with a sprayer, watering can or low pressure. No further action is required, just let the enzymes do all the work. After a while, filthiness will disappear.

Do not apply when outdoor and surface temperatures are below 8°C, neither when rain is to be expected within 24 hours. Do not use when temperatures are high and avoid working in plain sun.

IKO pro Self Cleaner is to be diluted with water in a proportion of 1:1 to 1:5, in function of the degree of filthiness:

- Severe pollution: dilute 1 L product with 1 L water and apply abundantly to the surface.
- Normal pollution: dilute 1 L product with 2 L water and apply abundantly to the surface.
- Feeble pollution: dilute 1 L product with 3 L water and apply abundantly to the surface.
- Preventively: dilute 1 L product with 5 L water and apply abundantly to the surface.

± 10m² with 1 liter diluted product depending on the filthiness
