

# **Roof&Wall Cleaner**

## **Description:**

Liquid and mildly acid cleaner that removes pollution and deposit of atmospheric origin on all all types of substrates, like roofs and walls.

As efficient, for more than 90% based on natural raw materials and for more than 90% biodegradable.

Scrubbing or the use of a pressure washer is not reuired. The result is noticeable after just a few days.

The packaging is made of 100% recycled plastic.

#### Use:

IKO pro Roof&Wall Cleaner is used for: flat and pitched roofs (bitumen roof felt, slate-roofed, tiled, thatch, corrugated, ...); facades (bricks, concrete, plaster); terraces and garden furniture.

Caution is advised when the product is applied or splashed on certain types of powder coatings. First test the product on an invisible spot.

Given its acid nature, the cleaner can attack materials based on limestone.

#### Packaging:

Jerrycan of 5L (item number 02400405)

#### Storage:

 $\ensuremath{\mathbf{2}}$  years in the hermetically sealed packaging, when stored in a dry, cool and frostfree place.

Partly used containers may be resealed and used again after correct storage.

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure upright position.

# **Application:**

First remove large dirt accumulations manually for faster results.

Always shake the product before use.

Do not apply at ambient and substrate temperatures < 8°C and when rain is expected within 24 hours. Do not apply at high temperatures and in full sun.

Apply IKO pro Roof&Wall Cleaner undiluted on a dry or slightly damp substrate with a brush or sprayer.

Let IKO pro Roof&Wall Cleaner soak in, the cleaning will happen automatically.

# **Consumption rate:**

From 5-10 m<sup>2</sup>/L, depending on the degree of dirt.
